The Hobe Sound Community Chest (HSCC) has awarded a \$50,000 grant to the Capital Campaign of the Council on Aging of Martin County to help build the Charles and Rae Kane Senior Center.

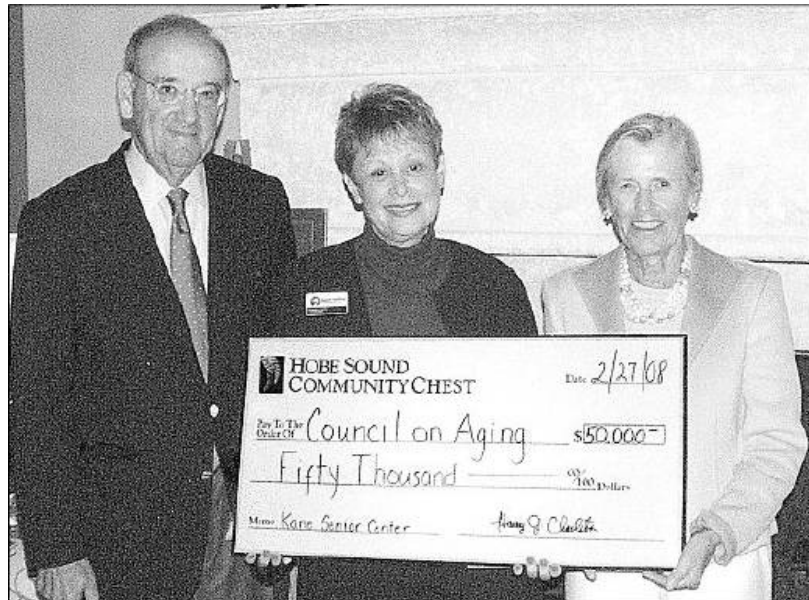
Harry Charlston, president of HSCC, presented the award to Council on Aging President and CEO Barbara A. Kauffman at a recent gathering.

The money will underwrite a "storefront" in the new facility, where seniors can access federal, state and local services. The Council on Aging will offer the storefront space to be shared by five senior-related organizations.

Charlston noted in his presentation that the storefront will serve the large senior-citizen community in Hobe Sound.

Kauffman added, "Through this grant, the Chest is helping to provide a one-stop venue that will ensure a continuum of care for seniors and their caregivers."
